Ethiopia is the land where coffee was discovered and the buna ceremony is an important part of the culture. Ceremonies are used to stay connected with neighbors and talk about life. The intimate ritual consist of three rounds being served. Abol, Tona, Baraka are the name of the services, each one with its own meaning.

"The first is for pleasure.

The second provokes contemplation.

The third is a bestow of blessing."

Our ceremony last up to 3 hours; includes the coffee being roasted, ground, brewed, and sipped. Session serves up to 10 guest. It also includes an appetizer as well as set up and breakdown.

We do ask for bookings to be placed 1 week in advance.

Total cost for this experience is only \$300.
